



Students must be 16-21 years old, U.S. Citizen and Larimer County resident, high school senior on track to graduate, and meet both of the following eligibility requirements:

- **Low income:** receiving public assistance i.e. food stamps, TANF, SSI, etc. or meet local income threshold. (Individual with a learning/mental/physical disability diagnosis is considered household of one for income purposes.)
- **Challenge to employment:** teen parent, learning/mental/physical disability, IEP/504, probation, foster care, homeless, or past offender record

Designing Your World

Ages: 14-16 | June 20-24 | 9:00 am - 4:00 pm | \$530

CSU faculty and students will work one-on-one with participants in design activities chosen to simulate real-world, engineered robots. Each student will design, build, test, iterate, and demonstrate an Arduino-controlled robot that represents a simplified version of real-world autonomous vehicles, and a remote-controlled underwater robot that represents a simplified version of real-world remotely operated vehicles (ROV). Students will be able to use 3D printers to build personalized elements of their designs.

Engineering Your World

Ages: 13-14 | June 13-17 | 9:00 am - 4:00 pm | \$500

CSU faculty and students will guide participants in fun and engaging activities designed to simulate a collaborative laboratory environment. Each student will: build a saltwater circuit and DC motor; design and build a swamp cooler, Mars rover egg-lander, and artificial bicep; create, construct, and test the strength of a bridge made of spaghetti, prosthetic leg, and clay boat; test and analyze sunscreen; and test and modify the chemical composition of slime to maximize its "bounce" factor.
