
DRAWING (1240)

Credit: 5

Grades: 9th – 12th

Prerequisite: 2-D Design Requirement: Fine/Applied Arts

This class will provide an opportunity for students to improve their drawing skills while encouraging them to think and express themselves creatively. Students will explore the use of a wide variety of techniques and media such as pencil, conte, charcoal, color pencil, markers, pen and ink, and pastels. At Rocky Mountain High School, portraiture and figure drawing is emphasized. Drawing is recommended before taking other art classes. There is a material/supply cost for this course.
