
DECA & FBLA will be holding our kick-off meeting, Wednesday Sept. 8 during lunch.

PSAT National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT) 10/13/2021

Attention Juniors:

The PSAT NMSQT test will be given at RMHS on Wednesday, Oct. 13th. This is a national date so we are only able to offer it on this day. <u>This exam is suggested for all **Juniors** as practice for their Spring SAT exam as well as for Juniors who are hoping to qualify for College Board's **National Merit Scholarship**. Sophomores may take the PSAT NMSQT, however all 10th graders will also be required to take the PSAT this spring (as part of state mandated testing) at no cost. We **do not** suggest that **9th graders** take this exam since it is geared towards Juniors and they will stay need to take the PSAT 9 in the Spring.</u>

Students may only qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program when they take the PSAT-NMSQT in the fall of their junior year and display high scores. We strongly encourage Juniors who tend to score in the 90% and above on standardized testing to take this exam.

The fee for 2021 is \$20.00. **To Register**, please **use SchoolPay online or your student may go to the fee window and pay by October 6th**. Students will receive a reminder a day before about arrival time, bringing a calculator and #2 pencils (not mechanical) and coming to the Auxiliary gym on that date. Doors open at **8:00 a.m.** and pre -administration begins right away. Please register soon since we have a limited number of tests available!

<u>NOTE: This test day is on a Finals day for 1st quarter classes. Students, make sure you talk to your teachers before the test day. You will miss period 1 & 2 for this exam.</u>

Their knowledge can point you in the right direction in the college process. If you don't know your counselor very well, now is the time to make an appointment.

Your counselor can help you the most if you take the time to talk to him or her about your goals, personality, and academic record. If you already have a list of what you want in a school or a list of possible colleges, bring it. The more information you provide, the more your counselor can aid in your college search. And don't be shy about asking questions. Counselors are there to answer students' questions and even enjoy doing it.

Stay in contact with your counselor throughout your college search. Your counselor can help you to clarify your goals, see whether your grades and courses are good enough for the colleges you're considering, and develop a plan for the rest of the admission process.

Parents and students don't forget that you can see who your counselor is in StudentVUE. (It looks like your 5th class.)



Attendance Protocols

Call in method:

- 1. Give student's full name.
- 2. Student's ID number (this is essential as we have over 2000 students).
- 3. Parent or guardian's name.
- 4. Date of absences and periods.
- 5. The reason for the absence.

We will mark your student absent if a reason is NOT given.

ParentVUE method:

- 1. Go to the PSD website at https://www.psdschools.org/
- 2. Select *Parents* in the blue at the middle of the page.
- 3. Scroll down under Quick Links on the right side of the page and select ParentVUE.
- 4. Select the blue *ParentVUE* tab on the next page right in the center.
- 5. Select I am a Parent.
- 6. Enter username and password.
- 7. Once in *ParentVUE* select the blue *Report an Absence* tool.
- 8. Enter date of dates, reason, and a brief note to explain why.

We will mark your student absent if a reason is NOT given.

9. Press the blue save button at the bottom right.

PSD using digital tickets for athletics

To increase safety, security and convenience for fans and community members, the Poudre School District Athletics Department will use digital tickets for football, volleyball, basketball and wrestling at all four comprehensive high schools, effective immediately. The move to digital ticketing allows for faster delivery of tickets to fans, contactless transactions, and flexibility for ticket holders.

As part of the policy change, purchasers will no longer receive a physical ticket at the gate. They will access digital tickets through the mobile Ticket Spicket app or online.

Students who purchased an Activities Pass and show the Activities Icon, located on their student ID, will be admitted without needing to purchase a digital ticket.

To purchase digital tickets:

Search Fort Collins High School, Fossil Ridge High School, Poudre High School, Rocky Mountain High School or Poudre School District. Tickets sales will open at noon every Sunday for the upcoming week of high school events. If there is a time or date change to the game, your tickets will automatically be adjusted. All seats are general admission.

French Field Guidelines

PSD Athletics encourages fans not to bring any bags; however, **the following will be permitted for those entering French Field**:

One clear bag no larger than 12" x 12" x 6" OR a one-gallon clear freezer bag (Ziploc brand or similar). Bags should be made of plastic, vinyl, or PVC.

• In addition, fans may carry a small clutch bag/purse no larger than 4.5" x 6.5", with or without a handle/strap.

• Each ticket holder, including children, may carry an approved clear bag and a clutch bag/purse.

• All other bags are prohibited when entering French Field. These include backpacks, camera cases, and purses larger than 4.5" x 6.5".

• Soft and flexible seat cushions are permitted.

• Disposable, crushable bottles, empty and without a cap, are permitted.

• Diapers and wipes may be carried in a clear bag; however, diaper bags are not permitted.

• Additional clothing, etc., are permitted if carried loosely or in an approved clear bag.

• Small cameras, binoculars cell phones may be carried loosely or in an approved bag.
